we can face the fact that if traditional OCs do not apply we will not have organizers.

SL stressed that it was a long tradition all three pony championships to be together, which was easier for the NFs and it was great experiences for the pony athletes.

NS explained what the plans are for development of venue on Avanches, SUI, and the willingness of the local OC to host EU Championships.

The board discussed the different approaches – from one side to have all three championships together and from other the possibility to bring new organisers of European Championships.

The board agreed that in the current situation we should not take the risk with OCs who do not have experience at organising European championships.

The board anonymously decided to recommend to FEI, the European dressage and eventing pony Championships 2025 to be allocated to Le Mans.

TS will inform FEI about the decision.
